Golfers are requested to REPAIR PITCH Marks on greens. Greens are soft and if pitch marks are repaired immediately the recovery of turf is almost guaranteed and much quicker as against if the marks are left unattended.

The recent continuous spell of rains has been the longest wet spell which has impacted our daily course maintenance. Some regular golfers have complained about thick turf on the fairways

we have not been able to attend to due to conditions. Using equipment's on soft surfaces results in tire marks which become very difficult for us to remove.
